Directions & Parking

The SF County Fair Building is located at the Golden Gate Park (beside the Arboretum) offers easy access by public transport: MUNI and BART. The entrance to the SF County Fair Building is at the intersection of 9th Ave & Lincoln of the Sunset District. Loading and unloading will be on the parking lot located at the Lincoln Way entrance gate, and is about 20 feet away from the corner of 9th Ave.

There is an abundance of free parking in the park and on Lincoln Way before 8 a.m. Sunday street parking is free.

Garage parking at UCSF at Parnassus. The main entrance to the public parking garage is found at 2nd Avenue and Irving St. Inside the garage, take note of your parking level ("C" through "G"). The garage is located **seven blocks** to the event. Rate is \$24 per day.

There is also an underground parking at the **Music Concourse Garage** located inside the Park right by the Japanese Tea Garden. The garage is located **two blocks** from the event. Access to the north entrance of the Music Concourse Parking is from Fulton St. at 10th Ave. Access to the south entrance is at Concourse Dr. and Martin Luther King Dr. inside the park. The Music Concourse Garage is open 7 days a week from 7:30 am to 10 p.m. year-round and parking in the garage is encouraged. *Hours and rates:* Monday-Friday 7:30 a.m.-10 p.m. (\$2.50/hour)
Weekends 7:30 a.m.-10 p.m. (\$3.00/hour); Maximum \$24 per day.

By Automobile

From the East Bay - Napa, Solano, Contra Costa, and Alameda Counties (80)

Entering San Francisco from the Bay Bridge, Hwy. 80 South, exit at "Ninth Street-Civic Center". Turn left (west) onto Harrison Street, drive one block and turn right (north) onto Ninth Street. Drive 4 long blocks and cross Market Street, turning left (west) onto Hayes Street. Drive 4 blocks and turn left (south) onto Gough Street, go one full block and turn right (west) onto Fell Street. Continue 19 blocks to Kezar Drive (past Masonic, get in the left lane of Fell and continue straight as Fell veers to the left here and becomes Kezar Drive). Continue driving Kezar Drive as it veers to the right and becomes Lincoln Way. Drive 6 blocks until pass 9th Ave. There is a small gate to your right for temporary parking, loading and unloading for the event. Our volunteers for vendor registration will greet you.

From Marin and Sonoma Counties (101 and 1)

From the Golden Gate Bridge, take the 19th Avenue exit (on right 1/4-mile after toll plaza) onto Park Presidio Drive. Stay in the right lanes as you pass through Golden Gate Park onto 19th Avenue, where no left turns are allowed. Go two blocks; turn right on Judah, right on 20th Avenue, and right (east) on Irving. Follow Irving St down to 9th Ave. Turn left on 9th Avenue. Drive one block and past Lincoln Way. The SF County Fair Building is to your left. If you need to load and unload, go back to Lincoln Way and make a right. About 20 feet from the corner of 9th Ave and Lincoln is the loading and unloading area to your right. There is a small gate to your right for temporary parking, loading and unloading for the event. Our volunteers for vendor registration will greet you.

From the South Bay (101)

Take Highway 101 North (Bayshore Freeway). Follow the signs for 101 North/Golden Gate Bridge. As you approach San Francisco, stay in the left lanes and follow the signs marked "Bay Bridge/Civic Center." Merge on US-101 North towards Bay Bridge/Civic Center. Take the Duboce Ave/Mission St exit. Continue on Duboce Ave. Bear left on Market St. Stay in right lane and bear right on 17th St. Turn right on Stanyan St. Turn left on Parnassus Ave. Turn right on 9th Ave. Drive two blocks and past Lincoln Way. The SF County Fair Building is to your left. If you need to load and unload, go back to Lincoln Way and make a right. About 20 feet from the corner of 9th Ave and Lincoln is the loading and unloading area to your right. There is a small gate to your right for temporary parking, loading and unloading for the event. Our volunteers for vendor registration will greet you.

From the Peninsula (280)

Take Highway 280 north; stay in the left lanes and take the Golden Gate Bridge exit onto 19th Avenue (north). Proceed in the right lanes and turn right (east) on Judah Street. Follow Judah up the hill to UCSF. Judah becomes Parnassus. Turn right on 9th Ave. Drive two blocks and past Lincoln Way. The SF County Fair Building is to your left. If you need to load and unload, go back to Lincoln Way and make a right. About 20 feet from the corner of 9th Ave is the loading and unloading area to your right. There is a small gate to your right for temporary parking, loading and unloading for the event. Our volunteers for vendor registration will greet you.
